Dear Friends of Blue Sky Bridge,

As we approach our 30th anniversary in 2025, I am reflecting on this journey we've taken together at Blue Sky Bridge. It has been my honor to lead this organization for the past 12 years. While I will be stepping down on January 31, 2025, I am certain that Blue Sky Bridge will continue on its critical path as a **beacon of hope and resilience for Boulder County.**

With our Intervention, Therapy, and Prevention Education programs, **we create lasting change for children and families.** Thank you for your support so that we can offer our services free of charge to those affected by abuse.

Our Intervention Program supports families and gives children a voice. Brave children and teens talk about their experiences on their terms, with someone who understands how to hear them. Safe and supportive caregivers receive support, resources and referrals as long as they need it. And families have access to medical professionals to get all their questions answered.

Our Therapy Program helps children heal and grow. Trauma therapy measurably reduces trauma symptoms and our newest treatment model can even reduce the onset of PTSD while increasing communication in the family.

Our Prevention Education Program empowers kids and helps adults to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to abuse. In the last five years, our School-based Prevention Education program has grown 73%. Teachers value its results in instilling healthy boundaries, and we are seeing evidence that **our education program is reducing the incidence and severity of sexual abuse in Boulder County.**

We are grateful to our community members who support us financially and with their time and talents. From pro bono branding and systems consultants, to our team of education volunteers, to our terrific Board of Directors and Associate Board, **we can't do this work without you.**

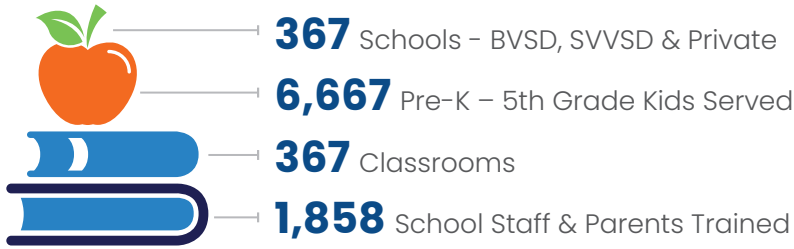

PREVENTION EDUCATION

Blue Sky Bridge believes that education is a tool for preventing child abuse. Our school program utilizes a three-tiered holistic approach that includes a presentation with tips and resources for parents, training for school personnel, and developmentally age appropriate presentations for kindergarten, 3rd, and 5th grade students.

We believe it is the responsibility of adults to keep children safe and are committed to helping adults learn how to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. We offer a range of trainings and outreach opportunities throughout the year to serve our partners and community members.

Intervention by the numbers

INTERVENTION

It used to be that a child would have to tell their story of abuse over and over to potentially more than a dozen school officials, police officers, doctors, attorneys, and social workers. Today, a child and their family is able to come to one place, our place.

By providing a centrally-located, child-focused facility and a coordinated response by all investigative agencies, we are proactive in our approach to helping families during child abuse investigations. We provide immediate intervention, forensic interviews, crisis intervention counseling, medical exams, family support, and follow-up services to child victims and non-offending family members.

THERAPY

Early intervention of mental health services is crucial to the healing process and the long-term health of child victims of abuse. Treatment is designed to reduce negative emotional and behavioral responses and post-traumatic stress symptoms after a traumatic incident. We offer a variety of evidence-based trauma-focused modalities – including Trauma-focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (**TF-CBT**), Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (**EMDR**), and The Child and Family Traumatic Stress Intervention (**CFTSI**) – for children who have experienced a traumatic event.

We offer therapy in both English and Spanish, and clients can receive services in-person in our Boulder or Longmont offices as well as tele-mental health.



EXPERIENCE, SHARED

“Blue Sky Bridge’s prevention education program has been a bright spot in our family’s education! My children have gotten a strong, age-appropriate foundation on which to build self-confidence and a sense of safety about their bodies. As a parent, I now have a simple shared language that I can use to talk to them about difficult topics like bodies, sexuality, and consent!”

As a millennial/child of the 80s and 90s, we were taught that bodies were a source of shame and taboo. I’m so glad as a parent to have this resource to normalize the topic and as a result, give my kids a healthy relationship to their bodies. 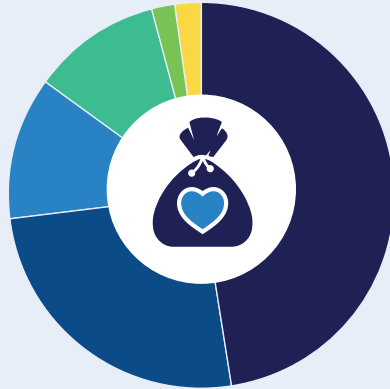

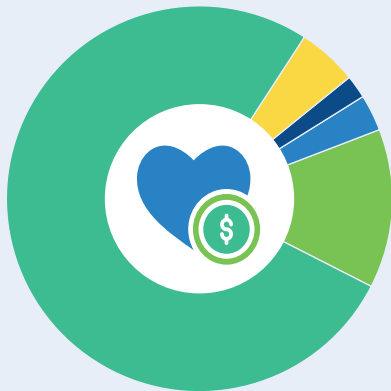
