



Blue Sky Bridge is Boulder County's Child Advocacy Center committed to addressing and eradicating child abuse and creating lasting change in the community.

Blue Sky Bridge has three programs: Prevention Education, Intervention, and Therapy. The Prevention Education program trains adults and works in schools teaching a curriculum that aligns with the Colorado Academic Standard for Comprehensive Health Education. Working with a multi-disciplinary team including law enforcement, social services, the District Attorney's office and community hospitals, the Intervention program provides skilled forensic interviews and medical exams of children as well as crisis counseling and support to non-offending caregivers. Trauma focused therapy is offered to children who have been forensically interviewed.

#### Advocacy Internship:

Advocate Interns serve as Case Support Advocates, and play an essential role in the services offered at Blue Sky Bridge; they are often the first friendly face children see when they come to the facility. Case Support Advocates assist with many aspects of cases, with research and office support. A scaffolded approach to learning is implemented in this internship and exposure increases based on educational needs and time commitment. Both Bachelor and Master's level internships are available.

#### GENERAL DUTIES

- Provide support to children/teens and their non-offending family members on site when they come for a forensic interview.
- Provide unobtrusive, age appropriate and trauma informed companionable playroom supervision. Utilize emotion-regulating activities to engage children.
- Observe family advocacy, as appropriate
- Observe cases and case staffings, as appropriate
- Attend Multidisciplinary team meetings, as appropriate
- Assist staff with projects, research and tasks as needed
- Attend required trainings, such as Orientation and Stewards of Children.

APPLY FOR THIS POSITION

- Complete the application and provide resume and three references.
- Be eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- Must be able to pass a background screening check (including FBI fingerprints, CO TRAILS)
- Participate in an interview with program staff.
- Have access to reliable transportation and to a telephone.
