



Blue Sky Bridge School Based Body Safety Program Overview

Blue Sky Bridge, Boulder County’s Child Advocacy Center, has been delivering child abuse prevention programming at elementary schools throughout Boulder Valley and St. Vrain Valley School districts for the last 10 years. Blue Sky Bridge, whose mission is to foster safe communities, healing and justice to end child abuse, is the local expert on child abuse prevention and their programming includes best practice topics based on CDC and Colorado guidelines.

Our school based body safety program encompasses a three-tiered approach

- Education for staff on mandated reporting and responding to a disclosure. *Available in on-demand video, virtual or in-person format.*
- Parent education about the program content as well as general prevention tips and an overview of childhood sexuality. *Available in on-demand video, virtual, or in-person format.*
- Body safety lessons for kindergarten and third grade students that are developmentally appropriate and involve a variety of teaching modalities including role-play, puppets and videos. *Blue Sky Bridge staff and volunteers deliver lessons to individual classrooms weekly for four consecutive weeks.*
